

Guidelines to making an application to the Artists' Panel 2009/2010

Closing date for application:

Friday 14 November 2008. Applications can be delivered by hand to IMMA on the closing date up until 5.00pm or can be post-marked for this date. Applications sent via email will not be accepted.

Notification date:

Approximately two months from the application date.

Criteria for selection

Applications for the Artists' Panel 2009/2010 should aim to demonstrate the following criteria for selection:

- Current and prior record as a practicing contemporary artist;
- 2. Effective communication skills;
- Experience of working with people in a variety of contexts;
- 4. Ability to plan, implement and facilitate projects.

Your application should include:

- 1. A completed application form
- 2. Your current Curriculum Vitae
- 3. Images of your art practice*
- 4. Additional related materials (optional)*

*Please read carefully the following terms and conditions before submitting images and related materials with your application...

Terms and Conditions for the Submission of Images and Related Materials

A: Do not include original artworks in your application

1. All material included in unsuccessful applications (excluding original slides with a stamped, addressed envelope) will be appropriately disposed of following the completion of the selection process.

B: Still images:

- 1. A minimum of 10 images/A maximum of 20 images;
- 2. The accepted formats are 35mm slides, CDs, DVDs, photographic prints and web-links;
- 3. Please provide an image list including title, year, material/process, dimensions;
- 4. Original 35mm slides will be returned only when accompanied by a SAE.

C: Video images:

- A minimum of ten minutes will be viewed of submitted video works. The minimum time will be divided evenly across the total number of submitted video works (i.e. if you send one video work, ten minutes will be viewed; if you send two works, five minutes of each will be viewed, and so forth).
- With video work over ten minutes in duration, including long show-reels, please provide your preferred time-coded point from which to begin viewing.
- 3. In case your application is shortlisted from the initial selection phase, please list the order in which you wish the shortlist selection-panel to view your video works (in order of your strongest preference 1,2,3,4, etc.).
- 4. These guidelines also apply to the submission of audio pieces.

D: Acceptable additional related materials (optional):

- Relevant excerpts from publications and press (photo/laser copies - no originals);
- 2. One catalogue of your choice (non-returnable).

Inclusion in the Artists' Panel 2009/2010 is subject to the selection criteria stated on this form.

The Artists' Panel 2009/2010 will be limited in number to thirty artists or less.

Selection to the Panel does not guarantee that an artist will be actively engaged by IMMA.

No canvassing on behalf of applicants prior to selection.

The decision of the IMMA selection process is final.
