TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT

Forbidden Fruit 2023 – Traffic Management Plan – Event Management Plan Appendix B

Restricted access may apply to traffic at times during show days on Kilmainham Lane, St John's Road and Military Road is required on safety grounds. The majority of patrons will originate from the greater Dublin Area, many of whom will travel by Luas or Taxi.

Traffic Management

The following temporary road closures to be implemented from 2pm on Saturday and Sunday 3rd & 4th June 2023;

- 1) Military Road junction with St. Johns Road West; No vehicular traffic onto Military Road from St. Johns Road West. All vehicles exiting HSQ carpark will be directed left onto Military Road.
- 2) Bow Lane West junction with James St; No vehicular traffic will be permitted down Bow Lane West with the exception of Local access for residents residing on Bow Lane West, Irwin St, Kilmainham Lane and Staff of the Garda Building on Military Road.
- 3) Kilmainham Lane junction with South Circular Road; No vehicular traffic permitted onto Kilmainham Lane from this junction with the exception of emergency access to Kilmainham Garda Station. Access for residents will be facilitated from James St / Bow Lane West.

Residents accessing / exiting Heuston South Quarter are encouraged to utilise the St. Johns Road West entrance.

It is envisaged that all other roads in the area will remain open during this event.

Signage

No Parking Signage will be put up on surrounding roads to avoid disruption to local residents parking.

Post Event

The following Temporary Road closures will come into effect during egress from RHK (approx. 22.15 to 23.15) for the purpose of crowd safety in terms of patrons leaving the RHK concert event. Note; When safe to do so Public Transport will be facilitated. At peak egress times diversions for public transport may be necessary.

1. St John's Road West (Outbound) will be closed by Gardaí for all traffic including taxi's and public transport vehicles, and will divert all traffic onto Heuston Bridge towards Parkgate Street and Conyngham Road.
2. St John's Road West (Inbound) will be closed by Gardaí for all traffic including taxi's and public transport vehicles, and will divert all traffic onto South Circular Road towards Parkgate Street and Conyngham Road.
3. Bow Lane West will remain closed to all outbound traffic from James Street including taxis and all traffic will be diverted outbound along James Street / Mount Brown.

4. South Circular Road (Outbound) will be closed temporarily at junction with Emmet Road, and traffic diverted left onto Emmet Road or right onto Old Kilmainham for duration of closure. Traffic inbound along Emmet Road will not be allowed turn left onto South Circular Road, but diverted inbound towards City Centre.
 5. South Circular Road (Inbound) will be closed temporarily at junction with Con Colbert Road and there will be no right turn for traffic from junction of N4 inbound towards South Circular Road.
- Cars displaying a disability badge will be permitted to use the East Gate to access the event.

ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT

- An independent Acoustics Consultant will monitor noise levels throughout the event in accordance with the 'Code of Practice on Environmental Noise at Concerts.
- A waste management contractor will ensure that the venue and immediate surrounds is cleaned after each event.
- Two cleaning operatives will patrol HSQ, Kilmainham Lane and the side roads from 14.00hrs to 23.00hrs each concert day and then a full clean to take place overnight and be completed by 07:00hrs each day.
